Giving wings to dreams of the poorest

Everything about education is free for students at the Vellai Thamarai School

PUDUCHERRY: Sitting cross-legged with a Tamil book on a small portable desk, a fifth grade standard student Srimathi. S at Vellai Thamarai (White Lotus) School dreams about studying medi-

Her logic for reasoning out this profession is rather simple. She wants to provide free medicines to the poor.

Born in a very poor family in Reddiyarpalayam, she envisions the need for free medicines to the impoverished. She realises this importance as she receives free education provided to her in this school.

"Everything here is free and we like coming to this school. We learn many languages, dance and even yoga," she says. She has spent eight years of her schooling here, starting from pre-kindergarten.

Sandwiched between Thavalakuppam and Bahour of Puducherry, the school is located in Chinnakattupalayam, about 17 km from Puducherry. This school provides free education for the children of daily wage labourers, broken families and single parents who struggle to make their ends meet. The school selects the poorest among the poor from nearby villages including Poosaripalayam, Keelalinjipattu, Melalinjipattu.
